Canopy Project Kawartha Lakes



The Canopy Project has the goal of increasing the urban canopy, through citizen-led projects, planting trees and creating valuable green canopies across all communities in Kawartha Lakes.

The first project at BGC Kawarthas Lindsay has now reached its fundraising target, funding the planting of 53 trees in 2021, with 20 more in 2022, along with a blueberry patch. Six new fruit trees will be added in the back of the property.

A tremendous thank you to all individual and corporate donors that have supported the project as well as the volunteer students and Club Leaders in Training that have helped to water the trees.



Now a third planting project is planned in conjunction with three local schools: St Mary's Catholic School, Saint Pope John Paul School and Adventure Quest. 60 trees will be planted with the help of students. The Canopy Project group is looking forward to working with more schools to initiate similar projects since it is a fantastic way to combine its interests of canopy development and education.
