## **Edgewood Dry Stack Stone Restoration Fund**



The EAB Edgewood Wall Committee successfully completed the heritage designation of the 130-year-old Edgewood Dry Stone wall in Bobcaygeon. The group launched the first physical restoration phase of the project in September of 2021. John Shaw Rimmington and his team of wallers completed the restoration of the Western wall the first week of October



Clean-up of the site has also been completed and a small garden will be installed next Spring where the old brick end post was removed and replaced with a historically accurate stone post. With the completion of the Western wall, the group now has its sights set on the Spring restoration of the 200-foot Eastern wall

If you haven't seen this magnificently restored section of the dry stone wall, take a walk or a drive down Canal Street near the corner of Hwy. 36.
